

Swimming Lessons During COVID-19

Due to the restriction in place with COVID-19, lessons will look a lot different from our normal lesson program.

- We will be able to offer Parent-Tot classes, Junior and Youth Swim Lessons.
- Class space will be very limited and will be on a first come, first serve basis, and subject to availability.
- Registration can be done online or by calling the front desk at (541) 336-3181 Ext. 1.
- All classes offered will be 2 weeks, Monday through Thursday, eight classes.

Below you will find some of the more significant changes to the learn to swim programs so that you can decide if this is the best fit for your family:

- 1. Levels 1 5 must have a parent/caregiver in the water with the swimmer. Instructors will be coaching from the deck
- 2. Swimmers should come to the pool in their swimsuits ready to swim. Changing areas will be available but are limited, changing at the completion of your swim is first come, first serve. It is recommended to be prepared to leave in your suit with clothes to put over.
- 3. Limited showers will be available in the locker room.
- 4. Once your class is over, you must exit the pool and deck promptly.
- 5. No water fountains will be available. It is highly encouraged to bring your own water. Water bottle fill station will be available.
- 6. A face mask or some kind of face covering must be worn when entering and exiting the facility. A face covering is not required to be worn when swimming.
- 7. You may not be allowed in, until pool staff have finished cleaning and it is safe to enter.
- 8. You may line up no earlier than 10 minutes prior to your class time. If you arrive too early, please wait in your vehicle.
- 9. Entry and exit of the pool will be designated by signs throughout the facility.
- 10. Please follow signs and arrows that help guide you safely through the facility.
- 11. Classes will be 30 or 45 minutes long.
- 12. Guests trying to enter the building exhibiting COVID-19 signs will not be permitted entrance.
- 13. We are not able to accommodate spectators for lessons. Registration covers entry for participant and 1 parent/caregiver per child. In water support for the child can be a sibling of family friend 16 years of age or older. We will need contact information for all participants in the program, including parents and caregivers.
- 14. We are not able to accommodate makeup lessons.
